How to tell the history of the collaboration among key stakeholders

- Use a series of interviews to generate rich histories of plebiscites, strategic planning, and other past or current deliberations or agreements relevant to your project
- Gather, organize, annotate, and archive relevant documents and past writing with an emphasis on group talking points, collective agreements, strategic plans, and other results of past multi-stakeholder agreements and deliberation processes
- Ask community leaders and elders to respond to prompts in the funding opportunity that ask for community history.
- Ask community members to explain why the specific groups applying chose to work together.
